Tests are completed over several sessions within the testing window. Each session can last between 60 and 100 minutes.	
NWEA English and Math 3x Science 2x	District	This assessment lets students know how well they are mastering Math Standards as well as assist teachers in developing lessons and interventions.	The time impact on students is 45-60 minutes per test. This assessment is administered in the Fall and Winter. Total number of hours for school year: up to 2 hours.	Teachers may assign short assessments once a month so students can monitor their progress as they master the standards.
