Bond Measure Resolution

Following months of discussion and research, the District 51 Board of Education voted unanimously Tuesday to approve a bond measure for the Nov. 2, 2021 ballot.

The measure, if passed by voters, will raise \$115 million to rebuild Grand Junction High School. Additional funding for the project will be provided by a \$10 million Building Excellent Schools Today (BEST) grant from the state and \$19.5 million in remaining funding from the 2017 Bond Measure.

In addition to rebuilding the high school, the bond measure will retain the art building and refurbish the east gym. The bond measure is expected to cost owners of a \$300,000 home \$5 or less per month in property taxes (a specific estimate will be known this fall, once the county completes assessed property valuation work).
