NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mesa County Valley School District 51 Board of Education hereby authorizes the Superintendent to enter into an agreement with Hoskins, Farina and Kempf to expand legal services to include legal advice and representation for the Board of Education.
