NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO ENROLL IN CONNECTION WITH EXTENSION OF DEPENDENT COVERAGE TO AGE 26

Individuals whose coverage ended, or who were denied coverage (or were not eligible for coverage), because the availability of dependent coverage of children ended before attainment of age 26 are eligible to enroll in the Mesa County Valley School District 51 Medical Plan. Individuals may request enrollment for such children for 30 days from the date of this notice (12/08/10). Enrollment will be effective either October 1, 2010 if retroactive premiums are paid, or February 1, 2011. For more information contact the Benefits Department at 254-5121.

NOTICE: LIFETIME LIMIT NO LONGER APPLIES AND ENROLLMENT OPPORTUNITY

The lifetime limit on the dollar value of benefits under Mesa County Valley School District 51 Medical Plans no longer applies. Individuals have 30 days from the date of this notice (12/08/10) to request enrollment. For more information contact the Benefits Department at 254-5121.
