Each session can last between 60 and 100 minutes.	
NWEA/Computer/English and Math twice per year. Science once per year.	District	This assessment lets students know how well they are mastering Math, English, and Science Standards as well as assist teachers in developing lessons and interventions.	The time impact on students is 45-60 minutes per test. This assessment is administered in the Fall and Winter.	Teachers may assign short assessments once a month so students can monitor their progress as they master the standards.
