This information can be used to identify the types of language supports and services that should be provided to students to help them succeed in the classroom.	This assessment is administered in January. Reading is 45 minutes. Listening is on CD and varies by grade, approximately 25-45 minutes. Writing is scheduled in one session lasting 65 minutes (less time for grades 1-2). Speaking takes approximately 15 minutes per student.	The Listening, Reading, and Writing sections of ACCESS for ELLs can be group administered by Grade cluster and Tier level. The Speaking section is individually administered.
