




Drawing 3D Forms


What is FORM?: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9DIPs3T2dQk&t=60s
The elements of art are to art what the ABCs are to reading. This project uses the element of FORM. Art & Math Connection A 3D Drawing shows a subject in three dimensions: height, width, and depth. When you make a 3D Drawing, you are showing all sides of something, as well as where it is located in the space it occupies.






Step 1.

Draw a simple shape (square, circle, trapezoid).




Step 2.

Draw the same shape again, but this time draw it slightly above and to the right of this shape. It should overlap.



Step 3.

Connect your two shapes by drawing lines from each corner.



Step 4.

Add a shadow to your shapes well as a little shading beside to make it look like the shadow is being cast.

What other 3D shapes can you make? Can you name objects with that shape?
